As Fitness and Health Educators we would like to incorporate Drums Alive into our curriculum, specifically into our required freshman classes, Mindful yoga classes, Power-up classes and our Adapted Physical Education classes.

Drums Alive is a research-based multi-disciplinary drumming fitness approach to brain and body health and wellness. It is the only comprehensive, all-inclusive program in the world that applies drumming fitness protocols in a multi-disciplinary way through physical education, fitness, dance, music education, mindfulness, relaxation and inclusion strategies for the improvement of brain and body health, social-emotional learning and wellness. The implementation of Drums Alive uses multiple programs and modules that involve music, movement, rhythm and drumming to improve physiological, psychological, neurological, educational, rhythmical and socio-emotional ability.

Enhancing our curriculum with Drums Alive will help to serve the social and emotional needs of our students as prioritized with our district goals. Our project also reflects our Vision Statement: WPS aspires to be a world-class school system that develops the heads, hearts, and hands of its students and inspires them to be the critical thinkers, problem-solvers, artists and innovators who make contributions to their communities, our nation, and the world by focusing on "group drumming which opens the doors of communication and allows students to speak where words often do not pass. Music, rhythm, and dance enhance self-esteem, ensure a healthy workout, stimulate our minds, boost our creative potential, make us laugh, and connect us on many levels" (Remo, 2003).

How will your project advance innovation and excellence in the Wellesley Public Schools?

The Drums Alive program is about teaching the "whole individual" concept and adding the elements of rhythm, movement, cognitive education, socialization and teamwork, and right and left-brain activation. Integration of the cognitive and physical processes will create a balance for the body, mind and spirit. When teaching our students, we will create an enriched environment and allow time for creative expression.

Approximately how many students will benefit from this project, if funded?

Every freshman entering Wellesley High school, all Mindful Yoga, Power-Up and Adapted Physical Education classes which would be approximately over 600 students per academic year.
